



Firewise Donations – Need Your Help

Congratulations to all on the great progress toward our 2021 Firewise certification. Many thanks to all for your project work contributions and help with metrics over the last 10 months. We are in a good position for our upcoming re-certification in March.

The DPA Board made the dumpster days, hydrant painting, and Firewise signage possible by allocating funding toward these projects to reduce fire risk in Dollar Point. During 2020 more than 30% of DPA members participated in Dumpster Days, hydrant painting, and individual cleanup projects. The Dumpster Days removed 510 cubic yards of fire fuels. Our goal for 2021 is to achieve more than 50% member participation and remove even more fire fuel.

For 2021 the DPA board has increased the Firewise funding allocation by 70%. However, the amount will not meet the projected expenses for this year. The Board has asked that we request member donations and continue to apply for funding grants to help offset the increasing costs. Planned 2021 investments include scaling up dumpster days and Firewise signage. For example, scaling up dumpster days for 50% member participation requires a top loader for each day, multiple transportation trips with full dumpsters (last summer we filled 13 dumpsters in a single day), and DPA staff for traffic control and dumpster loading. The more fire fuel we haul out the safer Dollar Point will be.

The Firewise committee is asking for donations to help fund 2021 Firewise projects that reduce wildfire risk to your home and DPA facilities. Please consider \$20, \$50, or other amounts to help keep our Dollar Point fire safe. If you are able to help, please fill out the following form and send it with a check to the DPA mailing address (P.O. Box). At the Dumpster Day events, we will be asking for donations as well as checking membership IDs for all who are dropping off green materials.

Will donations be tax-deductible? While DPA is a non-profit organization, we are classified as a recreational association rather than a public charity or charitable foundation (a 501c-3 tax

classification). Thus, donations to DPA for Firewise are not tax-deductible.
