Our committee is continuing to reach out to our bordering neighbors to assist them in fire safety.

- WEEK of January 11 - 15 - Leave your tree by the bear box on your regular pick up day and they will take and dispose of it for free

### **SAFETY REMINDERS**

- GAS METERS: Need to be accessible and clear of ice and snow (gas leaks can occur when damaged by ice and snow)
  - FIRE HYDRANTS: Need to be free of snow and accessible
  - FIRE EXTINGUISHER: 1 on each floor and in working order
  - DETECTORS: Fire and Carbon monoxide— CHECK BATTERIES!
- KITCHEN: Keep grease cleaned up on stovetops and ovens (*have a fire extinguisher easily accessible*)
