Hope you are all enjoying our beautiful Tahoe weather and enough snow to have some fun!

As you well know, sometimes the stormy weather creates power outages that can last a few hours to a few days. BE PREPARED with flashlights (fresh batteries), candles, non-perishable food not requiring cooking, sleeping bags, and extra blankets for warmth. If you have a wood stove or wood-burning fireplace, bring in extra wood to avoid going outside. Pulling shades down can reserve heat in the home.

While we wait for Spring, here are a few tips to be ready.

Sign up for Placer County Alerts at <u>www.placer.ca.gov</u> to stay informed on severe weather, evacuations, unexpected road closures, etc.

Check trees near power lines for limbs/branches that are too close and could cause problems in heavy wind or snow. Liberty Utility will come out and inspect and if needed, trim branches for free. To set up an appointment contact Eric Oiler at ericoiler@libertyutilities.com or 530-546-1708.

Free Fire Property Compliance Inspections performed by NT Fire fill up fast once the snow melts. Set up your appointment early by going online to ntfire.net. At the time of inspection, the fire department can also check compliance of neighboring properties.
