FIREWOOD STORAGE

It can be hard to find the right spot to store your winter firewood where you can access it after it snows but is still safe from fire. North Tahoe Fire recommends you stack your wood away from your structure, and most important is wherever it is stored it should be completely covered with a fire resistant tarp. These tarps can be purchased at any hardware store and from Amazon. Below are pictures of uncovered UNSAFE, and covered SAFE.
