Summer is here, sky's are blue, and the outdoors are ready to be enjoyed!

Fire awareness and preparation are essential in keeping our outdoor environment fire safe. Here are a few reminders:

- 1. Continue to remove fire fuel such as pine needles, pine cones, dead branches and trimming or removing manzanita.
- 2. Keep roofs clear of pine needles.
- 3. Cover firewood with fire resistant tarps
- 4. CHARCOAL BBQ and WOOD BURNING fire pits are banned.
- 5. Be prepared with an evacuation plan, have go bags packed for family and pets
- 6. Check batteries in your smoke and carbon monoxide detectors

Be observant of Red Flag Warnings. These warnings are announced through the National Weather Service when certain weather patterns occur that contribute to extreme fire danger. When in effect, the use of propane bbq and fire pits are not allowed.
