NT Fire reminds us each year to be sure we have reflective house numbers on our bear boxes in the event of a fire or emergency so they can find your home quickly. DOLLAR POINT POOL OFFICE has free reflective numbers!

While you are out for a stroll in your neighborhood, a quick check of the hydrants to make sure they are easily visible in the event of a fire is a way to help keep us all safe. Report any issues to our committee.

WILDFIRE SEASON IS HERE. Cleaning our properties (especially getting rid of manzanita) is essential to our safety as a community. As the summer comes upon us and as covid restrictions lighten up, we will be having educational speakers come to talk to our community about fire prevention and awareness and evacuation process.

FireWise asks us to maintain stats on homeowner costs to remove green waste and maintain defensible space, including replacing roofs. If you have paid others to clean and remove flammable vegetation from your yards or replaced a roof, please give those numbers to Nate Walker on our committee who reports them to FireWise for our annual re-certification.
