Snow has begun to fall, and we look forward to winter sports and spending more time indoors. Now is the time to focus on home safety.

FALL/WINTER CHECKLIST

- * inspect and clean fireplace and wood stoves
- * **SMOKE DETECTORS** (install new batteries, have one on every level of home, in each bedroom and in hallways in sleeping areas)
- * **CARBON MONOXIDE DETECTORS** (replace batteries, have on each level of home)
- * **Check Fire Extinguishers**
Have a minimum of one on each floor of home (by heat sources in kitchen, laundry, heater, etc)
- * **REFLECTIVE House Numbers on Bear Box** (free in DPA office)
- * **Defensible Space Inspections** are free and available until snow is too deep. Inspections can be set up on ntfire.net website or call 530-583-6911
- * **Keep gas lines and meters** free of snow and ice buildup
- * **Fire Hydrants** - if you have one near your property keep it clear of snow and debris 3 ft around

Our committee works closely each year with North Tahoe Fire and it's associated agencies to stay current on the latest information to help our community stay safe in the event of a wildfire.
